Dear FtP Subscribers and Friends –

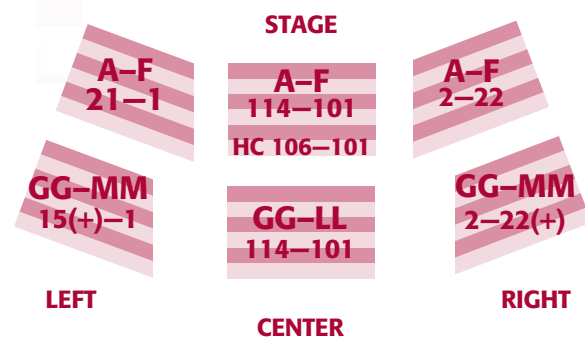

Unable to sleep, Elaine Wheeler paces the living room of her Manhattan townhouse, troubled by unsettling memories and vague fears. Her husband tries to comfort her, but when he steps away for a moment Elaine screams as she sees (or believes she sees) the body of a dead man in the window across the way. The police are called, but find nothing except an empty chair. The plot moves quickly and grippingly as those involved – Elaine's old friend and house guest Blanche; the inquisitive and rather sinister man who lives next door; and the nosy German maid Helga – all contribute to the deepening suspense and mystery of the play as it draws towards a riveting and chilling climax.

What becomes a legend most? For a couple of Jazz Age entertainers, it's all about fame, fortune - and murder. This Kander & Ebb classic, with Book & choreography by Bob Fosse set in prohibition-era Chicago, is a satire on corruption in the administration of criminal justice and the concept of the "celebrity criminal." Based on a 1926 play of the same name by reporter *Maurine Dallas Watkins* about actual criminals and crimes she had reported on, Chicago won six Tony Awards in 1997, including Best Revival – Musical.
